



## Child Protection Trainer

### Position's Purpose

To facilitate the development and provision of Child Care, Safety and Protection within the Network of Callan Services for Disabled Persons.

### Responsibilities

#### Mission

Develop an understanding of the values, philosophy and mission of the Catholic Church and Edmund Rice and a readiness to build the services of Callan Services National Unit (CSNU) on these foundations.

Work with others within Callan Services National Unit to foster and develop an organizational culture within Callan Services National Unit programs which reaches out to disabled persons and others on the margins of society, respects human dignity, provides equality of opportunity, reflects cultural and ethnic diversity and respect, promotes human rights and contributes towards the actualization of people's potential.

### Scope of the Position

#### Service Delivery

- Working with the Director of Callan Services National Unit, the Coordinator of Callan National Training and Services and other stakeholders in the development and implementation of a Child Care, Safety and Protection policy and procedures for the Network of Callan Services
- Participating in capacity building activities in Child Care, Safety and Protection as required and also capacity building activities in other areas of community-based rehabilitation (CBR) as negotiated with the Coordinator of Callan National Training and Services.
- Providing capacity building in Child Care, Safety and Protection knowledge, skills and attitudes to staff members and members of the Board of Governors in the Network of Callan Services and to personnel from other agencies as negotiated.
- Carrying out monitoring and quality assurance activities in relation to the work of Trainers delivering Child Protection Foundation Training Workshops, other associated workshops and Callan SERC staff members having signed the Codes of Conducts
- Participating in the work necessary to obtain accreditation for the training being provided in the area of Child Care, Safety and Protection.
- Providing capacity building in other areas of CBR as requested by the Coordinator of Callan National Training and Services.
- Working with the Business Manager and the National Coordinator of Callan National Training and Services (CSNTS) to acquit for finances that have been received and expended and to monitor budget expenditure and project activities.
- Meeting at least monthly with the Coordinator of Callan National Training and Services to report on activities undertaken and to plan for activities to be provided as well as participating in the quarterly CSNU review and planning process.
